

numbers in kanji

Numbers written in **KANJI** are usually written vertically whereas arabic numbers (e.g. 1, 2, 3, ...etc) are used when Japanese is written horizontally.

After two lines of practising the numbers from 1-10 continue to write the numbers up to 30. In Japanese numbers from 11 - 19 are written '10 and 1' (十一) etc, 20 is '2 ten' (二十), 21 is '2 ten and 1' (二十一) etc.

Then write today's date and your birthday.

Note: January is the 1st month of the year, February is the 2nd, March is the 3rd, etc... In Japanese the month is written before the day. So 一月一日 is 1st January.
